## Season Pass Holder Course Care Agreement

In 2024 we are asking you, our regular players, to help keep Buffalo Grove Golf Course in the best shape possible. The following rules and regulations have been created to make the round enjoyable for all our players. As a season pass holder at the Buffalo Grove Golf Course, you will be expected to adhere to the rules listed below.

### **Basic Course Care (Rangers will observe):**

Your efforts with basic course care go a long way in assisting with the conditions of the course.

- Replace your divots.
- Repair your ball marks. Note: Complimentary repair tools available in the pro shop.
- Rake all traps after use.
- Keep carts outside the roped area and at least 20 feet from the greens. Under no circumstances and for your own safety should you drive a cart between the bunker and the green.

### **Course Rules:**

Buffalo Grove Golf Course has guidelines to help keep the course safe and to help keep the operation running efficiently for all our patrons. In the past, we have noticed a few basic guidelines violated frequently, thus creating the list of course rules below that we would like you to help with:

- Do not practice putt or chip on the 18<sup>th</sup> green prior to play.
- All golfers are required to pair up on carts. Arrangements for single rider carts must be made in advance.
- Play holes in order, do not jump around without permission from a ranger or staff member.
- Do not start on hole #10 without permission from pro shop or starter.
- If you have an issue with another group while on the course, please signal the ranger or contact the pro shop for assistance.
- Only hit range balls purchased from the Buffalo Grove Golf Course from the designated tee area on the range.
- Picking up range balls from the 10<sup>th</sup> or 18<sup>th</sup> fairway for later use is prohibited and is considered theft.
- No outside alcohol is permitted on the premises.
- Do not spend more than 3 minutes (per USGA) looking for a lost ball in the water or rough.
- All players must check in at the golf shop prior to play and have a valid receipt for the starter.
- Pace program will be in effect—keep pace with the group in front of yours. Expected pace varies depending on the time you tee off and how busy the course is. Pace of 2 hours for nine holes is considered acceptable.
- Please be early for your tee time. If you miss your tee time for whatever reason, you will be rescheduled at the next available tee time, there is no guarantee that you will be next on the tee if you come late.
- No five-some's are allowed on the course. Groups arriving with 5 players will be split into two groups.

### **Other:**

- Season Passes are valid from 4/1/24 until 11/22/23. If you purchase a 2024 season pass, a non-season discounted green fee of \$10.00 will be charged for play. 5-day season passes are not valid on weekday holidays.
- Season pass holders are responsible for making tee times and can expect occasional closures due to outings or events.

To execute the agreement properly, we have put into place the following warning system.

You will receive up to 3 warnings (2 official verbal warnings and 1 official written) prior to termination of your season pass privileges.

By working together, we can help maintain Buffalo Grove Golf Course for the golfing enjoyment of all its patrons.
